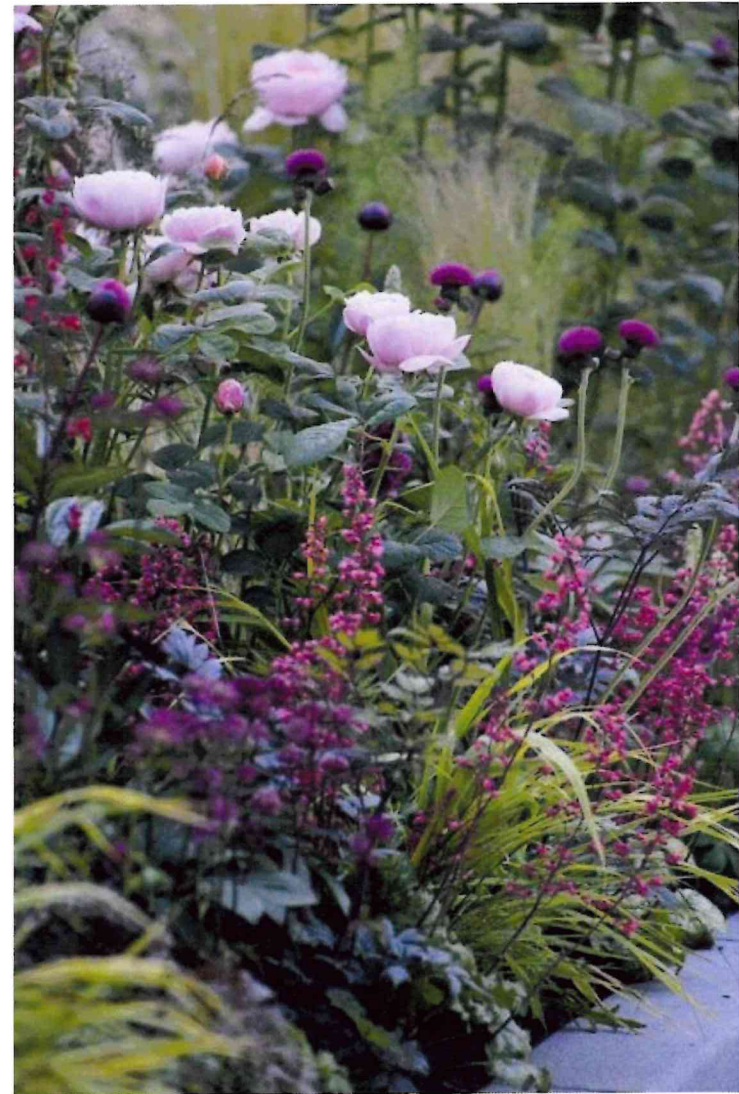
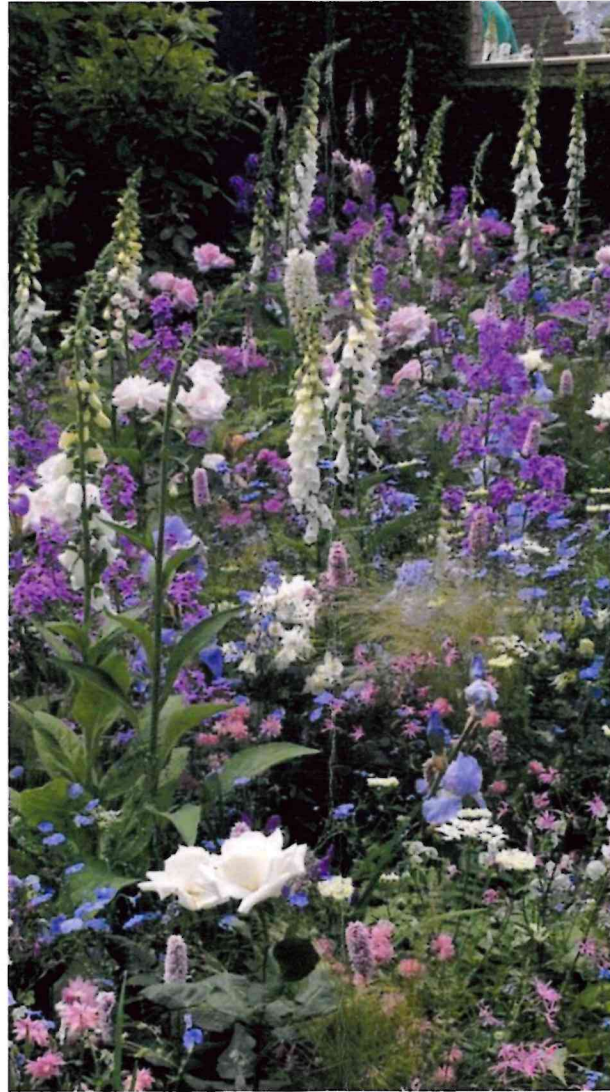
Vision Board & Scope Outline



Garden Beds & Landscape Plan

- Remove and re-pave existing driveway and stone paths.
- Replace backyard patio and construct pergola.
- Selectively remove & transplant overgrown shrubs & trees.
- Prune existing trees & shrubs.
- Add plantings- vines, ground covers, perennials.

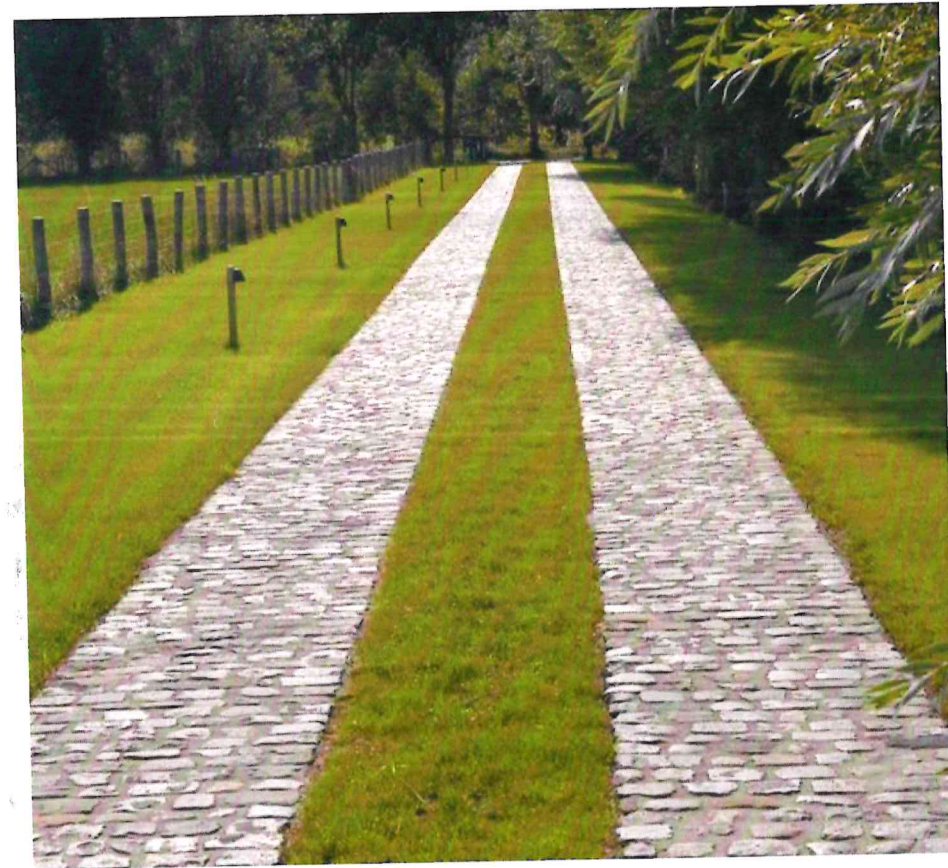
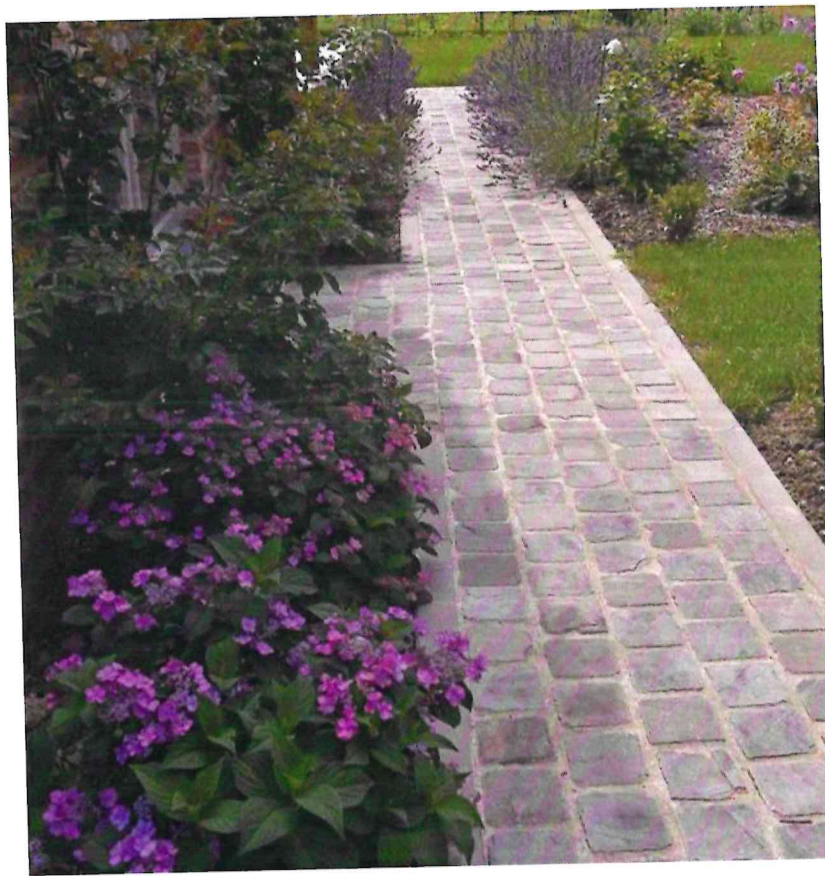
Front Yard Plantings



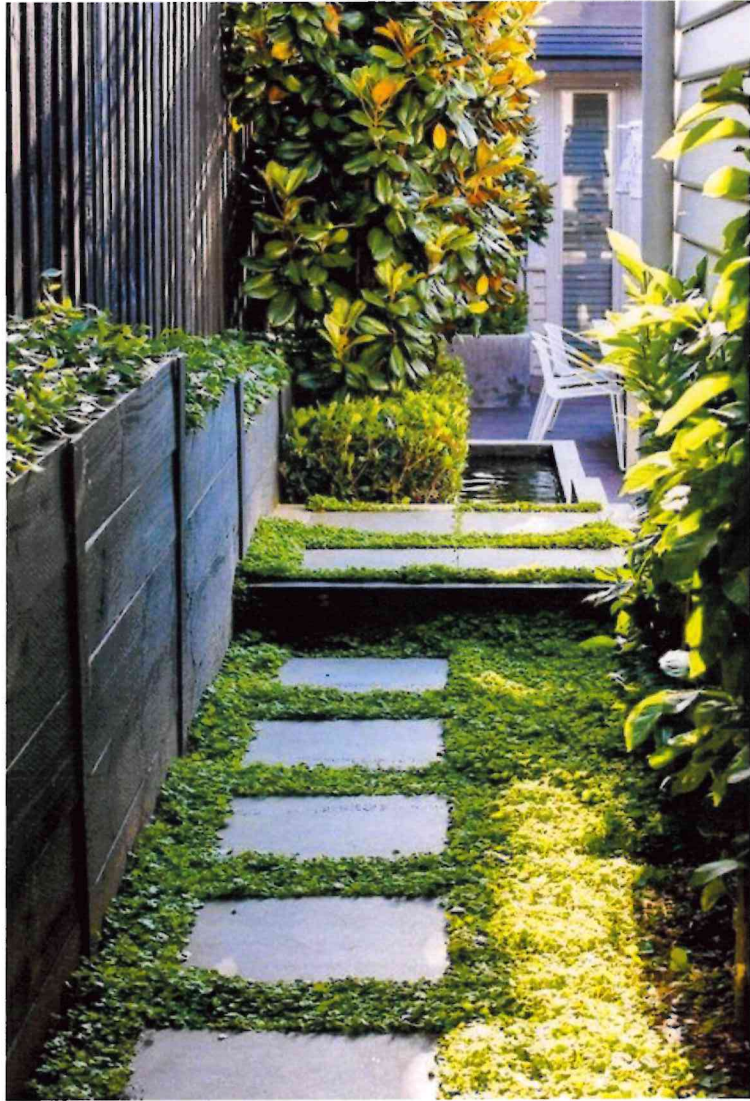
- Foundation plantings- simple evergreen hedge- tolerant of shade and sun. Cottage garden style plantings for mailbox garden beds, seasonal year round interest.

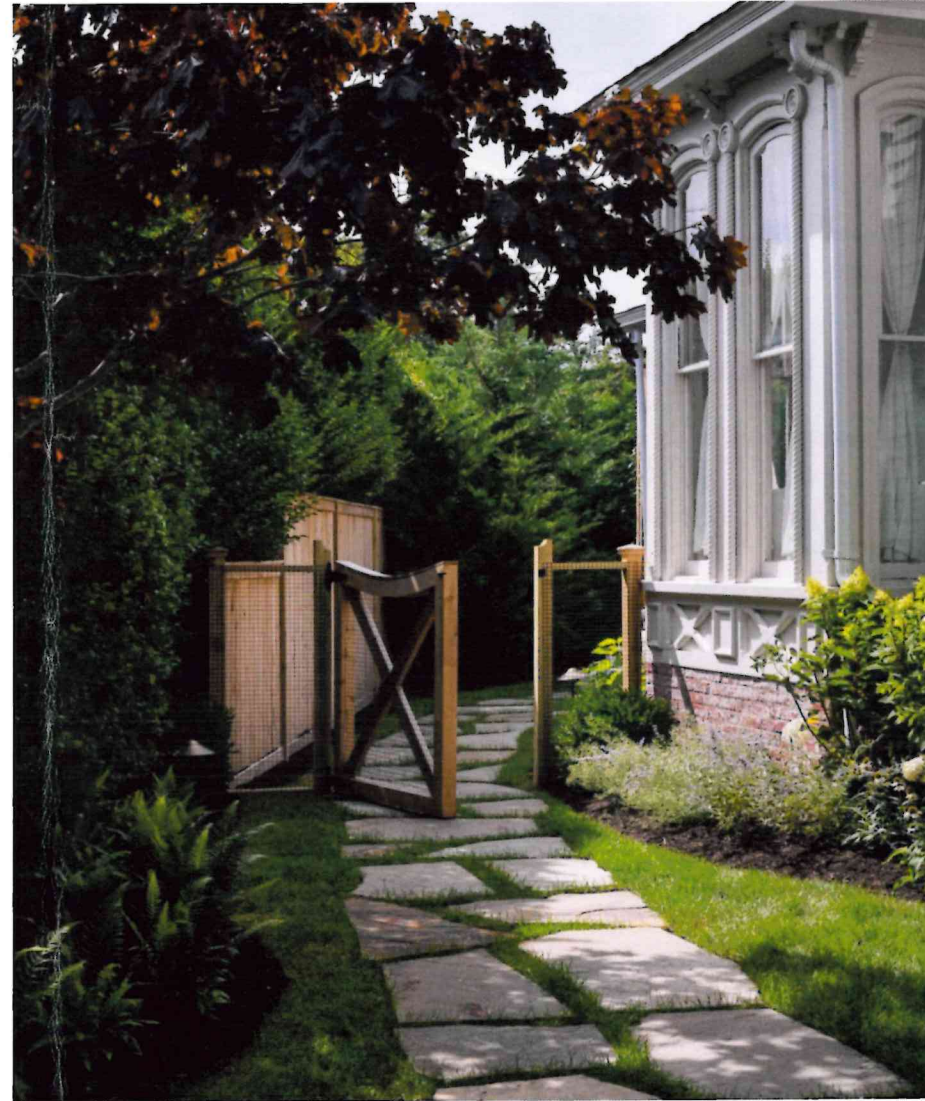
Jeep Track with Cobble Stone

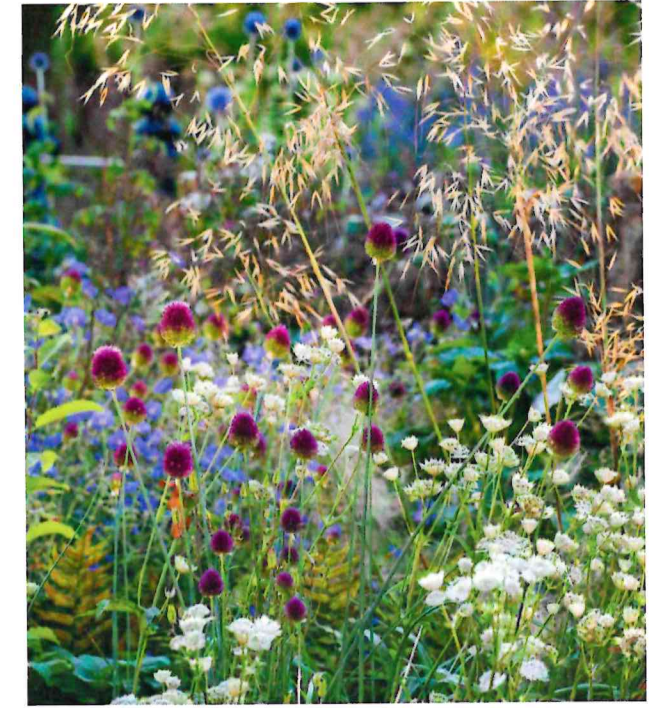
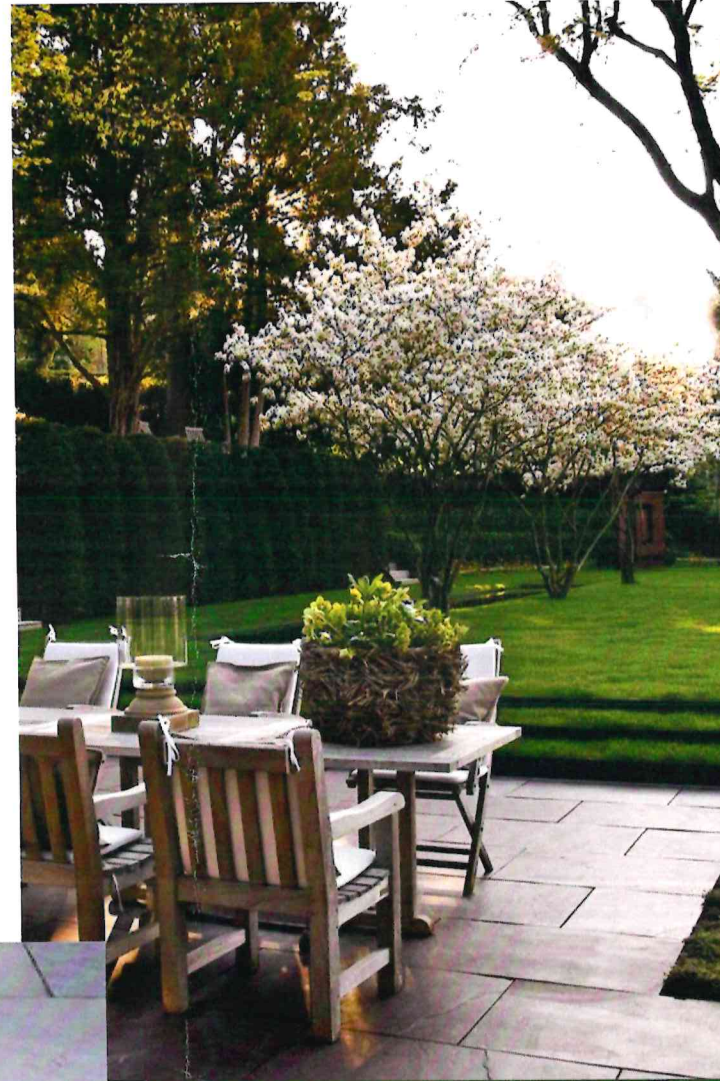


Singular square stepping stones (Bluestone)
with groundcover



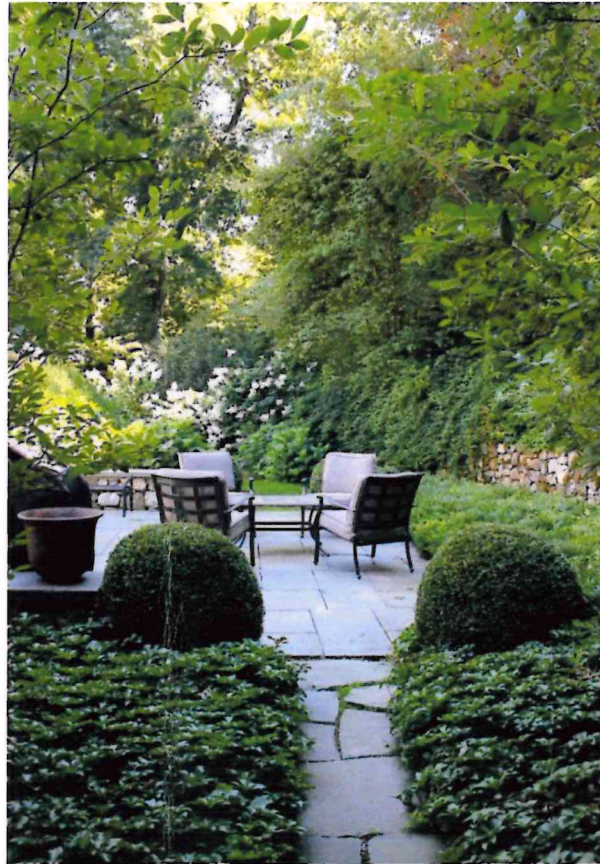
Fractured Bluestone stepping stones with

Patio Concept - Bluestone



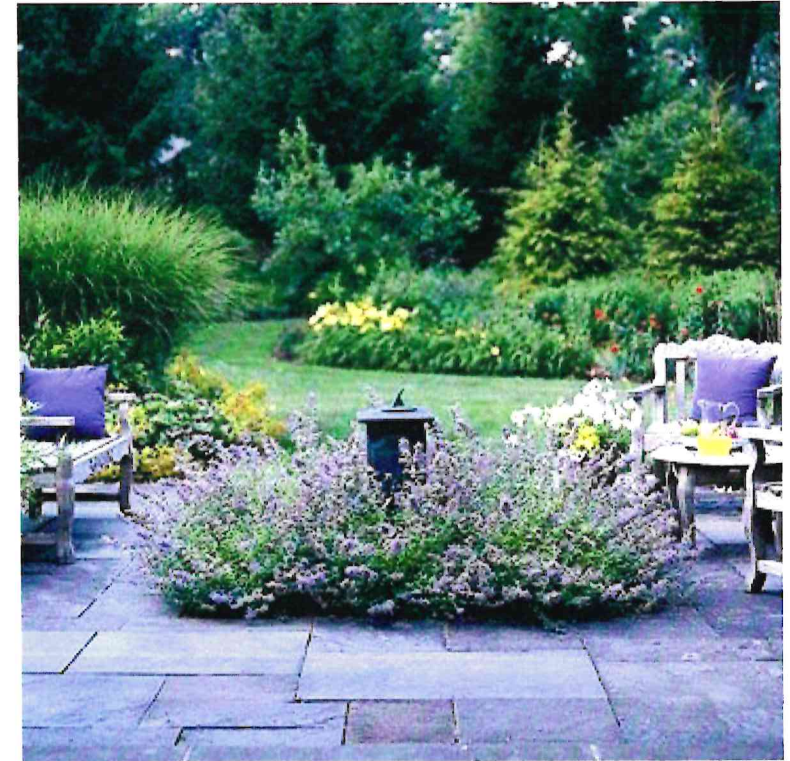
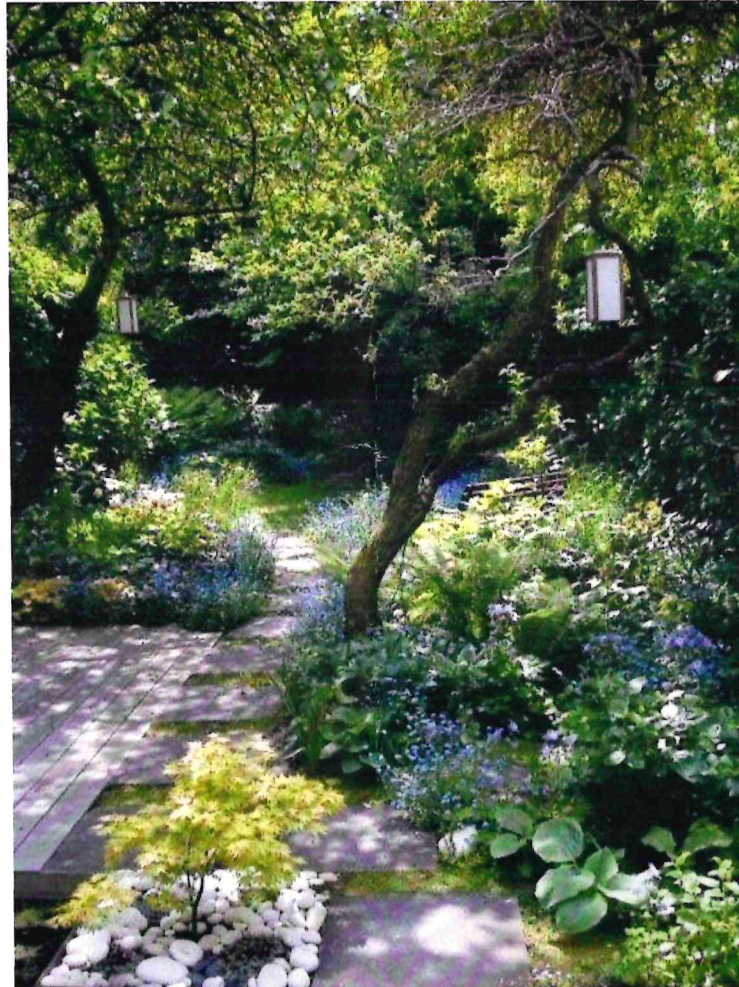
- Straight cut irregular pattern bluestone patio with straight edges uniformity.

Pergola Concepts



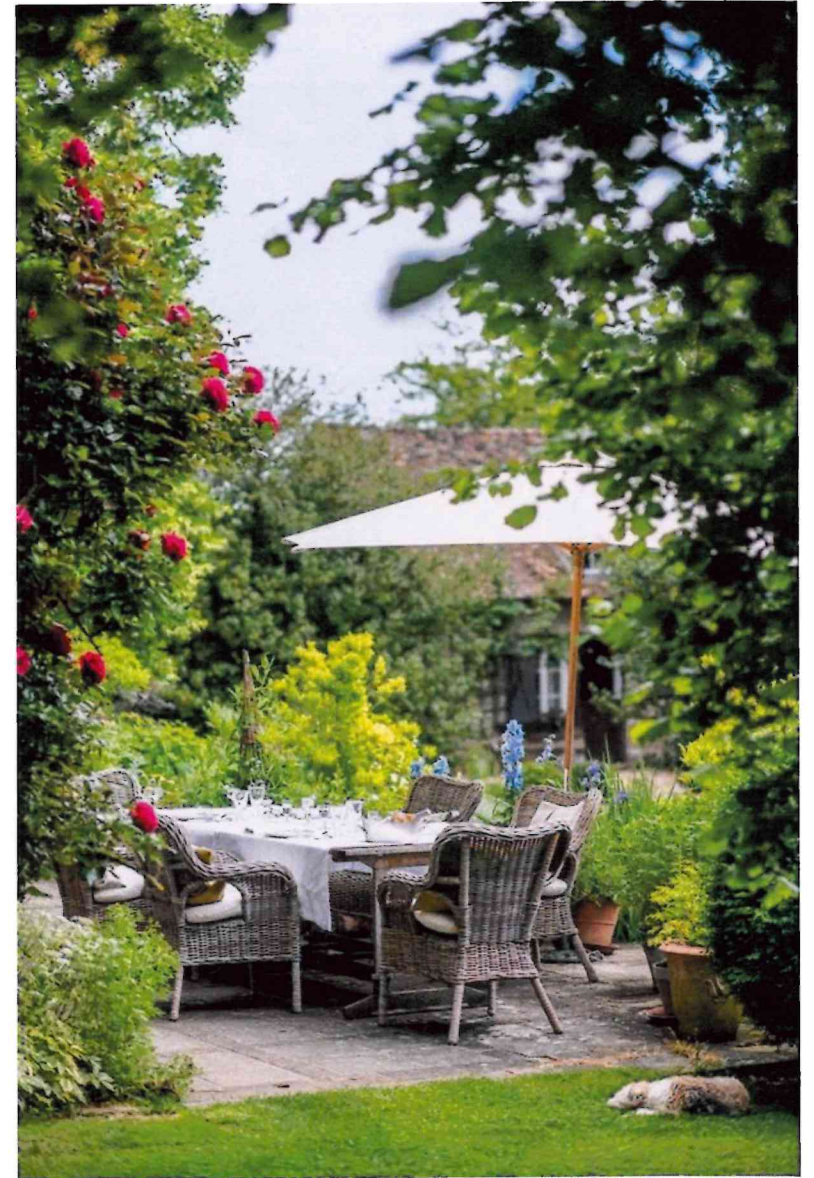
Natural Cedar with Climbing Vines

- Garden Bed Layout Concepts – integrated perennial beds under trees. Privacy evergreen plantings with a foreground of flowering shrubs

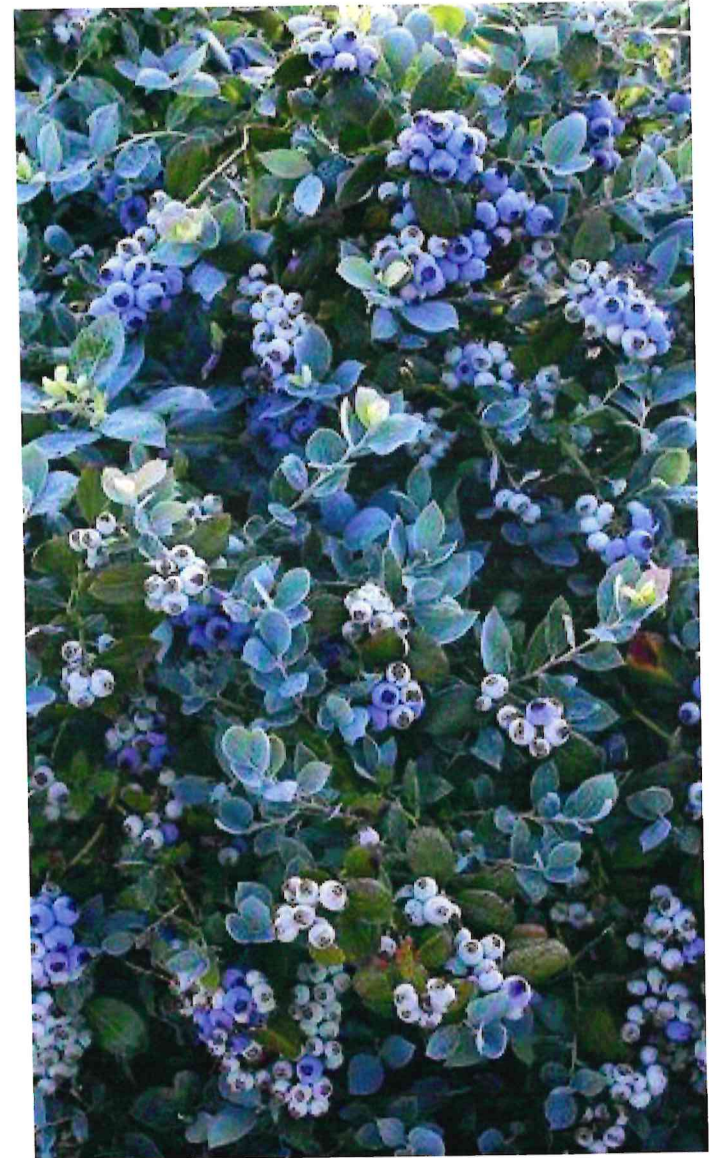

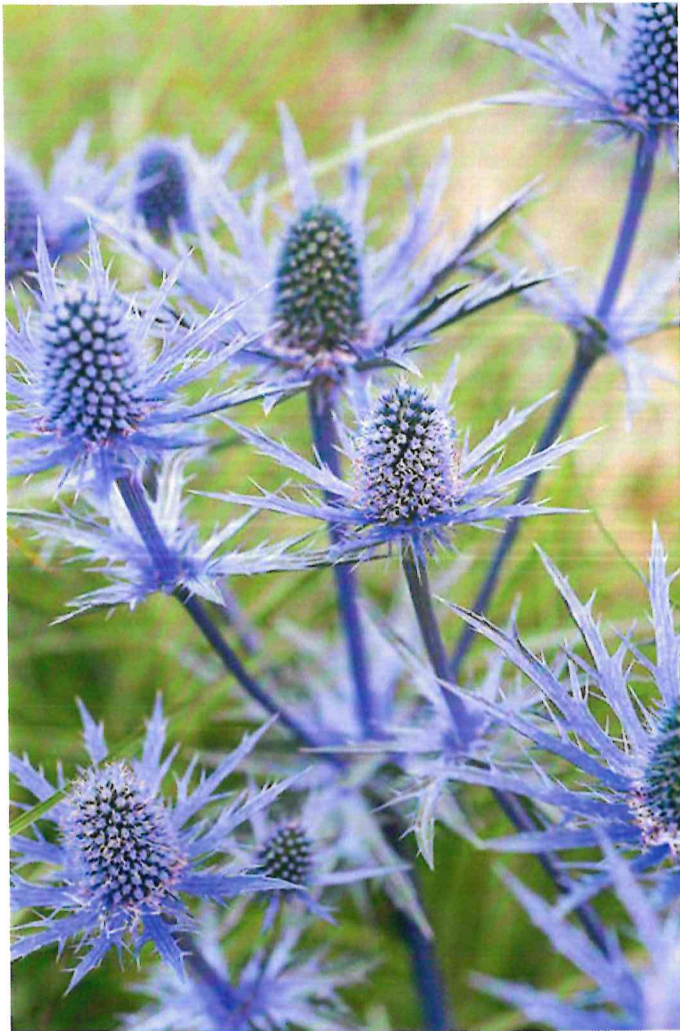

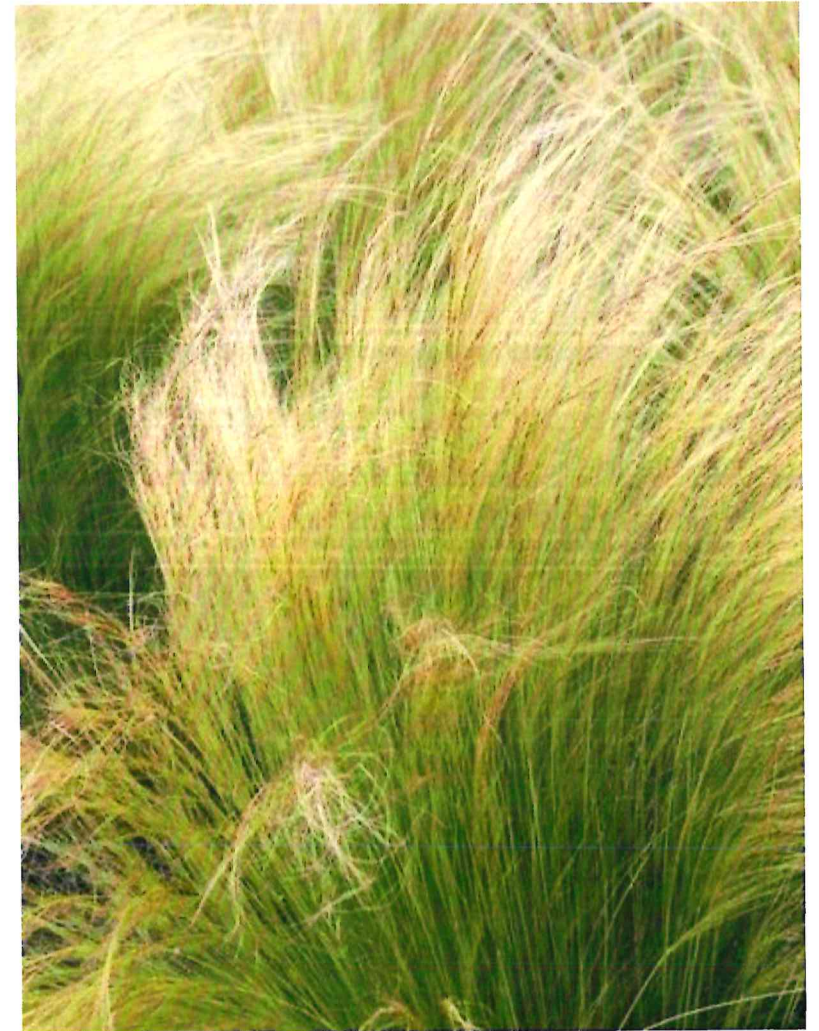
