    MS. PRIDAM: Hi. I'm Susan
Pridam, I live at 37 Lynbrook in Ridge,
New York. I have rented at 29 Front
Street for eight years.
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REGULAR SESSION - 3-1-2018 CHAIRWOMAN GIVEN: Okay. MS. SUESS: Hi. My name is Alexa Suess. I live at 123 Main Street in Greenport. I have taken on a partnership with Susan Pridam here.

We are looking to approve the two signs on that application. One is a hanging sign that should work with all of your regulations, and the other is a vinyl sign that is going to be displayed on the front window.
