2	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Good evening, everyone.
3	And I'd like to welcome you to the November Regular
4	Board Meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Trustees.

6	evening. He's caught trying to return from a holiday
7	with his family and the weather is not doing us well,
8	and Trustee Brennan will be joining us later.
9	I'd like to make a motion to open the Regular
10	Session meeting. Can I have a second?
11	TRUSTEE ROBINS: Second.
12	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: All those in favor?
13	TRUSTEE ROBINS: Aye.
14	TRUSTEE DOUGHERTY-JOHNSON: Aye.
15	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Aye.
16	Okay. Can we stand for the Pledge of Allegiance,
17	please?
18	(Pledge of Allegiance)
19	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Okay. If we could have
20	a few moments of silence for those who are Village
21	residents that have passed: Robert J. Bauman,
22	John P. Kujawski, Jr., Christine Marie Purcell,
23	Virgie M. Skeeter.
24	And I also would like to offer a prayer for the
25	terrible situations that are going on in the world

1 today with angry people.

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(Moment of Silence)

3 DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Thank you. You may be 4 seated. We have two announcements tonight. This coming Saturday is the The Festival of Lights and 5 6 Tree Lighting, which will be on Saturday, December 2nd, 2023, at 5 p.m. The Greenport Village 7 8 Fire Department is very active with that, along with 9 the Greenport Village BID and the Village itself. And I'd like to thank all of those who were very much 10 11 involved in it.

Also, there's an added surprise this year in that the Friends of Mitchell Park will be providing free Carousel rides during the daytime, and the Village will be carrying on with the free rides later on that evening. So I'd like to thank them very much for that.

18 The Annual Menorah Lighting will be held in
19 Mitchell Park on December 10th, 2023, at 5 p.m.
20 Pretty much that.

At this moment, I'd like to go to the public to address the Board on any topic or any agenda item.

KATHY HUBBARD: Kathy Hubbard, 208 Manor Place,
Greenport. I would just like to tell you all
something that you may not know. About 15 or 16

years ago, the BID -- you may know, I don't know -the BID bought little Christmas trees and put them all around the town, and they looked really nice. But after the holidays they had nothing to do with them, they didn't -- they had no use for them.

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6 So George, my husband, asked if he could take 7 all of the Christmas trees and bring them up to the 8 Little League field, and he wanted to plant them on 9 the outside of the fence in the outfield, and we did. So -- I'm losing my spot. They said yes. The 10 Village guys brought them up to the field on 11 12 Saturday. And on Saturdays after George got home from work, and on Sundays, his day off, we would go 13 14 up there, we'd space them out so that they would fill up the whole area, and then the guys from the 15 16 Village, they came and they planted them for us.

And I also -- we also bought and donated the 17 18 rubber home plate and the rubber pitching mound for 19 the Little League field. We bought and installed the 20 yellow protective shield that that is regulated to go 21 on top of the fencing. That took many, many 22 weekends, because it was a hard yellow plastic and it was really hard to do, but George and I did it over 23 24 several weekends. We had blisters and cuts, but 25 we -- we did it ourselves.

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1 And then on Thanksgiving Day, this past 2 Thursday, somebody called us and asked us if the Christmas tree in Mitchell Park that the Village put 3 4 up looked familiar, because it was one of the trees we had planted up at the Little League field many 5 6 years ago. So we went up there, and sure enough, right in the middle of the field one was cut down. 7 8 You could have at least taken it from an end so it 9 didn't look so obvious.

10 We know for a fact -- we know for a fact that 11 somebody came into Village Hall and wanted to donate 12 a tree, but I guess that didn't happen. So needless 13 to say, we were very upset and devastated about the 14 whole situation. We hope that in the future you will make more of an effort, advertise if you have to, to 15 16 get one donated, or even -- and even replace the one that you cut down. Those trees were healthy and 17 18 doing great.

DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Kathy, thank you very much for your comments, and we appreciate all the effort that you and the former Mayor did in all the work that you did up at Moore's Lane, we very much appreciate it. The trees, from my understanding, were looked at, because they were getting to the point where they were overgrown. I happened to be

1	involved way back when the Greenport Improvement
2	Committee did those trees. And yes, they gave them
3	to the Village, but their eventual plan was for it to
4	be at some point be Christmas trees that could go
5	into Mitchell Park and be replaced.
6	KATHY HUBBARD: Uh-huh.
7	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Okay? I'm not going to
8	argue, okay?
9	KATHY HUBBARD: No, I'm not either
10	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: I'm not, okay?
11	KATHY HUBBARD: but come on.
12	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: I was part of that
13	committee, Kathy, okay? So my understanding is
14	KATHY HUBBARD: That's funny that George
15	doesn't remember that, and you know his memory.
16	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: And you know mine.
17	KATHY HUBBARD: No, I don't, but
18	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Okay. I guess you
19	don't, okay. So, anyway, the goal is to replant
20	another tree there so that it will grow.
21	KATHY HUBBARD: I hope so.
22	DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: And they were they
23	were trimmed back so that the other trees wouldn't
24	die, because they were getting to the point where
25	they needed to be taken care of.

I understand there was somebody that donated a tree, but, 5 6 unfortunately, Paul, I believe it was a double trunk 7 and the Road Crew felt that they couldn't get it out 8 of the yard. 9 KATHY HUBBARD: Okay. All right. What about 10 the playground equipment? 11 DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: As far as the -- down 12 at Fifth Street? 13 KATHY HUBBARD: Yeah. 14 DEPUTY MAYOR PHILLIPS: Okay.
