4	MEMBER BURNS: I move that you take
5	it.

7	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Welcome to
8	the May 31st Work Session of the Planning
9	Board Meeting. It is about 4:10.
10	Item number 1 is to accept the
11	minutes of the April 26, 2018 and May 3,
12	2018 Planning Board Meeting.
13	MEMBER BURNS: So moved.
14	MEMBER THOMAS: Aye.
15	MEMBER FOOTE: Aye.
16	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Item
17	number 2, motion to approve the minutes of
18	the March 29th, 2018 and April 5, 2018
19	Planning Board Meetings.
20	MEMBER BURNS: Second.
21	MEMBER THOMAS: Aye.
22	MEMBER FOOTE: Aye.
23	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Item
24	number 3, motion to schedule the Planning
25	Board Work Session meeting for 4:00 p.m. on

1	June 28, 2018.
2	MEMBER THOMAS: Second.
3	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: I won't
4	be here, but I go along with that.
5	Motion to schedule the Planning
6	Board Regular Session meeting for 4:00 p.m.
7	on July 5, 2018.
8	MEMBER THOMAS: Second.
9	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: All those
10	in favor?
11	MEMBER BURNS: Aye.
12	MEMBER FOOTE: Aye.
13	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: So Item
14	number 5 is 104 Third Street, a
15	pre-submission conference for the site plan
16	review of Port 104 Inc. Represented by
17	Keith Bavaro, owner. The application is
18	for the approval of a permanent tent
19	structure for the property located at 104
20	Third Street. The property is located in
21	the WC (Waterfront Commercial) District.
22	SCTM# 1001-54-3.
23	MR. BAVARO: Hi. My name is Keith
24	Bavaro from Port Waterfront Bar and Grill.

104 Third Street in the Village of

1	Greenport. We are asking permission for
2	the temporary awning tent at that location.
3	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: It says
4	permanent. Didn't I read permanent
5	somewhere?
6	MR. BAVARO: Yeah. The structure
7	the awning itself will come down and be
8	stored at Mill's. They come and take it
9	every six months. But the actual framework
10	will be connected to the deck.
11	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: This?
12	MR. BAVARO: Yes. And the
13	building. We are looking we have the
14	tent up, set up. And we want to attach it
15	to the reverse gable, which takes you in
16	and out of the building. We won't be able
17	to do it this season, but for next season
18	we want to be able to have coverage so the
19	staff and patrons can come in and out of
20	the building without weather kind of being
21	an issue and food protection.
22	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Is it for
23	this whole structure?
24	MR. BAVARO: That would be the tent
25	going around the perimeter. Yes.

ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: This is 1 the connection that you are talking about. 2 3 MR. BAVARO: That is correct. 4 ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: So I 5 understand they have an issue with building coverage? 6 7 MR. PALLAS: There may be. We are still researching it but the -- this -- for 8 9 your purposes it is just the tent for the pre-submission conference. Once the other 10 11 issues are resolved then you will schedule 12 a hearing on just the tent as the change to 13 the site plan. 14 ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: I guess 15 when it comes back I wouldn't mind seeing 16 -- I hate to put you through the burden, 17 but some kind of rendering to see what it 18 is going to look like. Because it is 19 awfully big. It is almost 50 feet by 22 20 feet at some point. So that is definitely 21 making an impact on the aesthetics of the 22 environment. Even though I'm an architect 23 I that can't really figure out how it is 2.4 going to look.

MEMBER FOOTE: I would like to add 1 2 at this time that due to a conflict of 3 interest I am not going to weight in on 4 this matter. 5 ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Anybody else have anything to say about this 6 7 project? 8 MR. PALLAS: Just as a point of 9 information, the Village had approved the 10 tent as a temporary structure. And that --11 so it physically exists if you want to take 12 a look at it. The only --13 ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: It does 14 exist? 15 MR. PALLAS: It exists, the 16 temporary structure. It is not attached to 17 the building. That part couldn't be done 18 until this was done. They are permitted to 19 have it as a temporary structure. Which means after 180 days it would have to be 20 taken down, including the frame. They have 21 22 now decided they want to make it -- you 23 know, leave the frame up. And that is why 2.4 they are here before you. That is really

the heart of the issue. So you can get a

1	look at it.
2	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Okay. so
3	it is up now.
4	MR. BAVARO: It is up. Yes.
5	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Then I
6	don't need a rendering. I must be blind
7	when I walk by there.
8	MR. BAVARO: Please come take a
9	look at it. So we'll come full circle?
10	MR. PALLAS: As I said, there are
11	some issues that are unrelated to what is
12	before you that we need to be resolved.
13	But we can't it wouldn't make sense for
14	you to approve it because of these other
15	issues. So we will work with the other
16	issues. Once they are resolved, however
17	they get resolved, then it will come back
18	to you to schedule a hearing. You will
19	have the hearing. And take a vote.
20	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Okay. So
21	that is all we have at this time.
22	MR. BAVARO: Understood. Thank
23	you.
24	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: Thank
25	you.

1	MEMBER BURNS: Does this have to go
2	to the ZBA?
3	MR. PALLAS: It may have to. We
4	are researching that. It not for the
5	tent specifically. There may be other
6	ancillary things related to it.
7	MEMBER BURNS: So if we should
8	admit it
9	MR. PALLAS: Again, this was just a
10	pre-submission. So we are not the
11	agenda was prepared with to schedule the
12	hearing. But we are going to pull that off
13	the agenda for next week. We won't
14	schedule the hearing. So it will be a
15	non-issue for you guys.
16	MEMBER BURNS: All we need to do is
17	accept it.
18	MR. PALLAS: This Board had not
19	gone through that, as a routine matter, to
20	accept applications. So we are I would
21	just
22	MR. CONNOLLY: This is just a
23	pre-submission.
24	MR. PALLAS: Yes.
25	ACTING CHAIRMAN COTUGNO: So unless

1	there is anything else to say, Item Number
2	6, Motion to adjourn.
